- Very ambitious project, completion in 2 years, involving a design and advisory team assembled from government staff province wide, licensee staff and consultant staff.

- To produce an Uncomplicated Approach.
- To produce a Template
 Consistent with the 5 FRPA
 Stocking Standard Tests.
- To produce Template
 Options.

Long Term

- To assist in the
 Management of Species at
 the Landscape Level & in
 Increasing Species Diversity
 (Species Mixes and
 Densities).
- To link the MLS Template
 Outcomes to TSR.

Current MLS Proposal Concepts:

- Lump stands into Common Strata various criteria
- Volume standard Approach SI & Model dependent
 - Within 95% of target
 - Within Upper and Lower Goal posts
 - Calculate volume per strata or per plot
- MAI standard Approach
- Density Range Approach
- Separate standard for Regen and FG
- Survey all or not survey all openings in a strata
- Survey using 1.75m % occupancy or 3.99m WS or MSQ or Quadrat or OAF 1 gap assessment
- Higher brush competition allowances % or #'s per plot
- Broader species acceptability
- Sample population based on same harvest date
